SACRAMENTS


BAPTISM & CHRISMATIONS: Preparation is required. We encourage this to begin at least one month before the Baptism.

SICK CALLS : If someone is hospitalized, sick, in rest homes or unable to leave home, please let us know by calling the Parish office.


