SACRAMENTS


BAPTISM & CHRISMATIONS: Preparation is required. We encourage this to begin at least one month before the Baptism.

MARRIAGES: Arrangements six (6) months in advance.


CONFESSIONS: Sunday 12.15-12:45 PM & by appointment


NEW PARISHIONERS: Welcome to our parish family. Please be sure to register with our parish by calling the Parish House.
