
Sacrament of Reconciliation. Father Raymond is available for the Sacrament of Reconciliation before and after each Liturgy or by appointment.

Great Lent is a season of fasting and abstinence. Abstinence from the consumption of meat and meat products for all persons over 14 years of age on all Fridays of Great Lent. Fasting from all food and beverages (except for water and medicine) from midnight until noon is obligatory for all persons between 14 and 60 years of age on the following two important days: Ash Monday (Feb 27th) and Great Friday of the Crucifixion (Apr 14th). 
