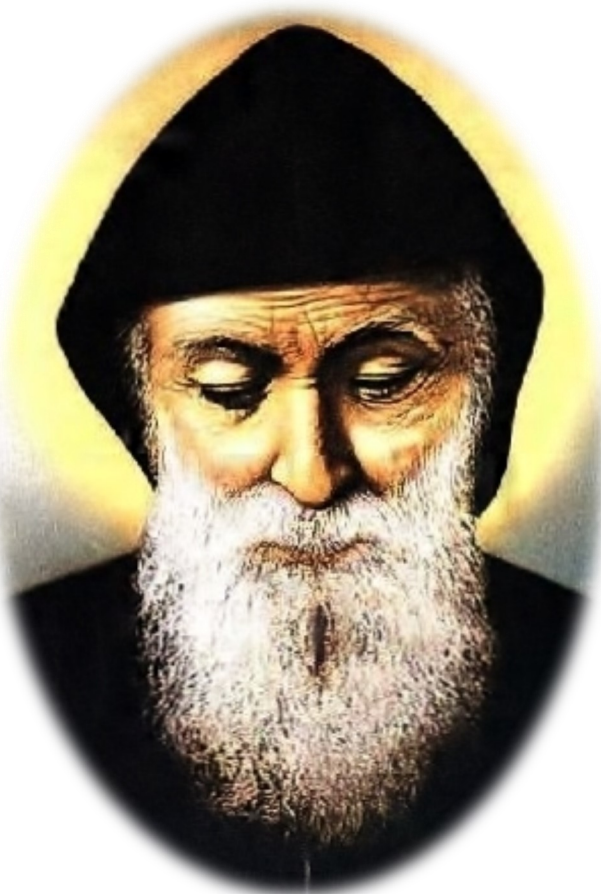


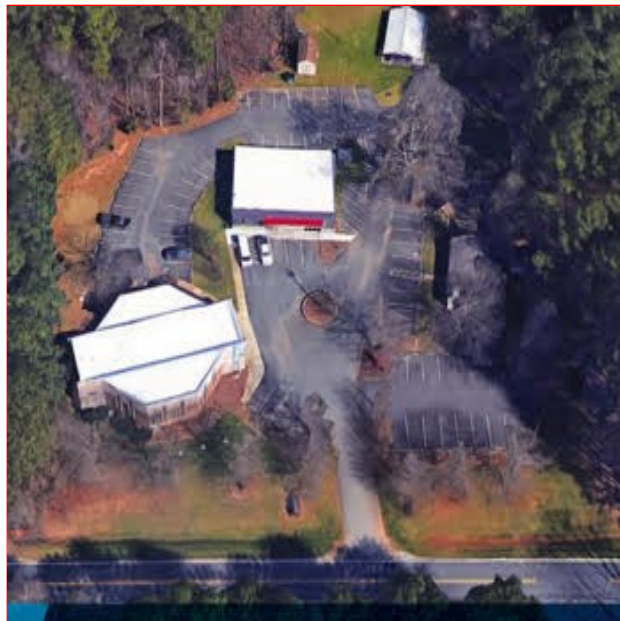
Feast of Saint Sharbel

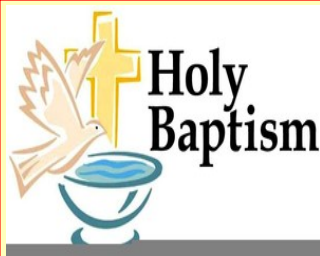

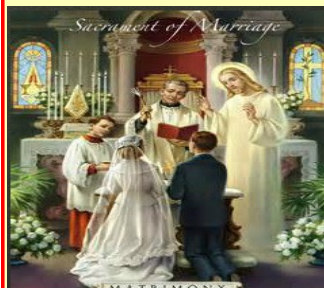

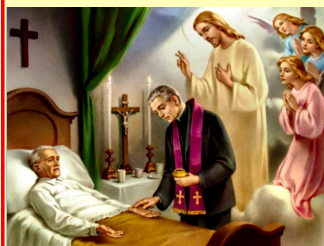
Sacrament of Marriage

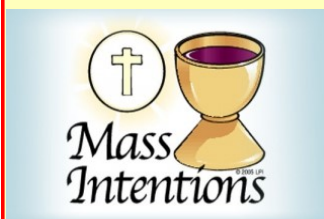
Communion to the Homebound
