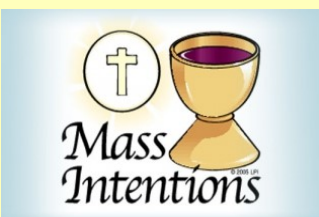
### **Communion to the Homebound**
