The Parish Council will meet after Summer vacation, on Tuesday September 4, 2018 at 7pm in the Rectory.



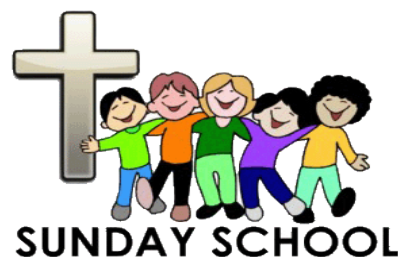
- **Ladies Guild meeting**

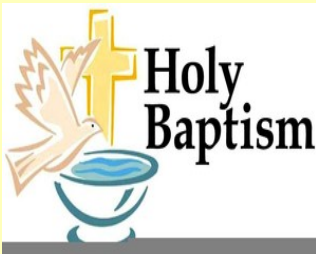

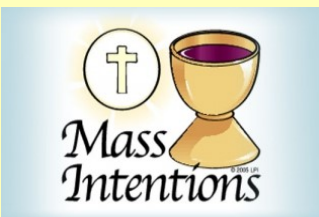
### **Communion to the Homebound**
