## Lent Schedule

Lent this year will start on March 4th with Ash Monday. The Liturgy will be celebrated with Blessing and Distribution of the Ashes at 7:00 pm.

Every Friday during Lent, starting on the 8th of March and until the 12th of April, we will pray the Stations of the Cross at 7:00 pm.

Hosanna Sunday, and afterwards, Liturgy will be celebrated at the new Church.

During Holy week, April 15 to April 18, we will daily celebrate the Liturgy at 7:00 pm.

Thursday of the Mysteries on the 19th, the Washing of the Feet.

Great Friday of the Crucifixion on the 19th, Signing of the Chalice at 9:00 am, and Jesus's burial at 7:00 pm.

Saturday of the Light on the 20th, Prayer of Forgiveness.

Resurrection Sunday on the 21st, Rite of Peace: Midnight and Morning Liturgies.

#### Lenten Observances

All Maronites, who are physically capable, are to abstain from meat on Ash Monday (March 4, 2019) and all Fridays of Lent

Ash Monday and Great Friday of the Crucifixion are also days of fasting.

Fasting in the Maronite Church involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon.

### St. John Maron

The Maronite Church, on March 2nd, celebrates the memorial of its first Patriarch of Antioch, John Maron. Since the second half of the seventh century, the See of Antioch was vacant, the monks of the Monastery of St. Maron elected a Patriarch, John Maron, who was a spiritual leader and a patriot who defended his people and accompanied them to Lebanon during their persecution.

Tradition says that he died and was buried at Kfar Hayy (Batroun) in the sanctuary which is consecrated to him.

Previously, our Church celebrated his feast on March 9, but Patriarch Josph Estephan transferred his memorial to the 2nd of March in 1778.

May his prayers be with us.
