

ASH MONDAY

This Coming Monday, February 24, 2020 is Ash Monday we begin the Season of the Great Lent. **Do not forget to fast this Monday morning.** The Mass with the distribution of Ashes begins at 6:30 pm.

MARONITE LENTEN OBSERVANCES

Great Lent is fundamentally a penitential season. Abstinence & Fasting are an important part of this season:

- 1. **Abstinence from meat and meat products** is observed on Ash Monday and on all the Fridays of Lent by all faithful from age 14 to 65.
- 2. **Fasting from food and drinks (except water and medicine)** is to be observed from midnight until noon on Ash Monday and on Great Friday of the Crucifixion. Those who are unable to fast because of ill health must perform other penances and acts of charity. The law of fasting binds all faithful between the ages of 18 and 60. Women who are pregnant are not obliged to fast.

I hope to see you Sunday and Monday so that we may properly prepare ourselves and support one another throughout this Lenten journey.
