

Jesus Hands Over the Governing Authority to Peter (John 21:15-20)

Jesus once again appears to his disciples after his resurrection, and this time poses a **seemingly simple question** to Simon Peter. And <u>not</u> just once, but three times (maybe as a way of subtly reminding Peter of the three times he denied his friend Jesus on the night he was arrested). One simple question asked **again and again**. And evidently Peter answers **easily** and without hesitation - the third time choosing to emphasize his love for Jesus even more forcefully and maybe even with a hint of disappointment that Jesus **doesn't seem to be accepting his answer**. And what does Jesus tell him? **"Feed my lambs.... Tend my sheep... Feed my sheep."** It's as if he is telling Peter, "My friend, I believe you, but **words simply aren't enough."** It's easy to **convince** ourselves that we love God. It's easy to **say**. It's easy to **believe**. It's relatively easy to **mean sincerely**. But there's one small problem --- it's <u>not</u> at all **easy to live out**. And if we believe Jesus, that's **all that really matters**.
