The ceremony of the Blessing of the Epiphany waters will take place during the Qurbono at 6:30 pm. Please arrive to Church on time for the Qurbono and bring your water bottles to be blessed in time for the Blessing Ceremony. **If you still have last year's Holy Water containers please return them for refills.**
