

Lenten Observances 2021

For us Maronites, Lent begins on Ash Monday, February 15, 2021 and lasts until Holy Saturday (April 3) at noon. The following Lenten guidelines are observed in the Eparchy of Saint Maron.

- All Maronites who are physically capable are to abstain from meat on Ash Monday (February 15) and all Fridays of Lent.
- Ash Monday and the Great Friday of the Crucifixion are also days of fasting. Fasting in the
 Maronite Church involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine)
 from midnight until noon. The rest of the day normal meals can be taken, but without
 meat. All Maronites who are physically capable are to fast on these two days.
