#### **Lenten Observances 2021**

For us Maronites, Lent begins on Ash Monday, February 15, 2021 and lasts until Holy Saturday (April 3) at noon. The following Lenten guidelines are observed in the Eparchy of Saint Maron.

- All Maronites who are physically capable are to abstain from meat on Ash Monday (February 15) and all Fridays of Lent.
- Ash Monday and the Great Friday of the Crucifixion are also days of fasting. Fasting in the Maronite Church involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon. The rest of the day normal meals can be taken, but without meat. All Maronites who are physically capable are to fast on these two days.

#### Holy Week Liturgical Schedule:

**Palm Sunday**: Blessed Palms will be distributed and we will process outside (weather permitting) or inside the Church. (11:00 AM)

**Monday & Tuesday**: Arrival at the Harbor Divine Liturgy and Benediction of the Holy Cross. (6:30 PM)

**Holy Wednesday**: The Rite of the Lamp, anointing with Holy Oil and Divine Liturgy .(6:30PM) **Holy Thursday**: Divine Liturgy and Washing of the Feet. (6:30 PM)

**Great Friday of Crucifixion**: Signing of the Chalice. (10:00 AM)

Great Friday of Crucifixion: Procession for Burial of the Lord. No kissing the Cross(6:30PM)

Holy Saturday of the Light: Prayer of Forgiveness. (11:00 AM)

Easter Sunday of Resurrection: Midnight and Day Divine Liturgy. (12:00 AM & 11:00 AM)

The Liturgies of Holy Week are an inspiration to us. We become more intimately aware of Christ's love, compassion, forgiveness and mercy for us. Hope to see you.

Please note there will be **NO** Liturgy on Saturday at 5:00 PM.
