Decree

ERECTING SAINT SHARBEL IN RALEIGH, NORTH CAROLINA AS A PARISH OF THE EPARCHY OF SAINT MARON OF BROOKLYN

hereas, the Maronite Mission of Saint Sharbel in Raleigh, North Carolina, is a Mission in the Eparchy of Saint Maron of Brooklyn of the Maronites; and

hereas, there has been significant growth in said community, spiritually, pastorally, and temporally; and

hereas, we have consulted the Eparchial Presbyteral Council concerning this matter in compliance with the provisions of CCEO Canon 280, § 2;

Dow, therefore, pursuant to the provisions of Canon 280, §2 of the Codex Canonum Ecclesiarum Orientalium, and Statute 210 of the Statutes of the Eparchy of Saint Maron of Brooklyn, we hereby decree as follows:

- I. That the Mission of Saint Sharbel, is hereby canonically erected and established as a Parish of the Eparchy of Saint Maron of Brooklyn of the Maronites; and
- II. That the Parish of Saint Sharbel in Raleigh shall embrace all the Maronite faithful residing in the entirety of the civil jurisdictions of the counties of Alamance, Beaufort, Bertie, Camden, Caswell, Chatham, Chowan, Currituck, Dare, Durham, Edgecombe, Franklin, Gates, Granville, Greene, Guilford, Halifax, Hertford, Hyde, Johnston, Martin, Nash, Northampton, Orange, Pasquotank, Perquimans, Person, Pitt, Randolph, Rockingham, Tyrrell, Vance, Wake, Warren, Washington, Wilson; and
- III. That the provisions of this Decree shall come into force on the First day of October, in the Year of Our Lord 2021.
