

What is the purpose of holy images?

The image of Christ is the liturgical icon par excellence. Other images, representations of Our Lady and of the Saints, signify Christ who is glorified in them. They proclaim the same Gospel message that Sacred Scripture communicates by the word and they help to awaken and nourish the faith of believers. The Body of Christ

The body of Christ is a term with three different but related meanings in Christianity. First and foremost, it refers to the Christian church all over the world.

Second, it describes the physical body Jesus Christ took on in the incarnation, when God became a human being.

Third, it is a term we use for the Eucharist.
