K-1: Draw the story of the Coming of the Holy Spirit, Acts of the Apostles, 2:1-12	K-1: In your own words, write a short paragraph telling us what liked about the story of the Holy Spirit.
2-3: Draw the story of the Healing of the Blind Man, John 9:1-12	2-3: In your own words, write your thoughts about Jesus' healing the blind man. (not to exceed 50 words)

POSTER OPTION:

7-9: Analyze the importance of the story of the Good Samaritan. (not to exceed 500 words)

- **10-12:** What does the story of Jesus and the disciples walk to Emmaus mean to you? (not to exceed 1000 words)
- 1- All entries must be the original work of the entrant. Any entries that are noticeably not the work of the individual will be disqualified.

(not to exceed 100 words)

- 2- Each student may enter only **ONE** category.
- 3- NO GROUP entries. This is an individual student competition.
- 4- Each parish may submit up to three (3) entries per category/grade level.
- 5- POSTERS MUST BE on 14 x 22 Poster Board Paper. Any other paper format will be disqualified.
- 6- Entries must be clearly marked, on the back, and grouped by age group with a paper clip or divider.
- 7- Individual participants can mail in their own entries but must indicate parish affiliation and city and state.
- 8- All entries must have the student's name, address, parish name, grade level and age (CLEARLY WRITTEN OR TYPED.)
- 9- All entries must be post marked by May 15, 2023
