

#### CONTEST GUIDELINES

- All entries must be the original work of the entrant. Any previously submitted entries or entries that are noticeably not the work of the individual student will be disqualified.
- 2) Each student may only enter in ONE category. No Group entries. This is an individual student competition.
- 3) Each parish may submit up to 3 entries per category/grade level.
- 4) Posters must be on 14 x 22 Poster Board paper. Any other paper format will be disqualified.
- 5) Entries must be clearly marked on the back & grouped by age group with a paperclip or divider.
- 6) Individual participants can mail their entries, but must indicate parish affiliation, city and state.
- Entries must have student's name, address, parish, grade level & age. Clearly written or typed.
- 8) All entries must be post marked by May 31st, 2023, and mailed to the address below.
